

## 英語（リスニング） スクリプト

## ○音声確認

これから音量が適切であるかを確認します。  
ポンという合図の後、音量調節のための英語を流します。これは問題そのものではありませんので、内容を把握する必要はありません。  
英語の音声は約30秒流れますので、その間に適した音量に調節してください。  
音声の最後に、イヤホンを外すよう指示があったら、すぐに外し、机の上に置いてください。  
それでは音量の確認を始めます。

M: Let's talk about the newsletter.

W: OK, let's check what we've got so far. We've decided to have one main story and one short story, right?

M: Right. And what about pictures? Should we have one for each story?

W: I'm not so sure about that. Maybe it would be too much. How about just for the main story?

M: That sounds good. Now, what will our stories be? We could do one about the students who visited from Hawaii. Maybe we can use one of the photos they sent us.

○試験問題（英語の音声は2回流れます。）

これからリスニングテストを始めます。  
この試験では、聞き取る英語は2回流します。質問文と選択肢は音声ではなく、すべて問題冊子に印刷されています。

解答をマークする時間は設問ごとにありますので、その都度、解答用紙にマークしてください。解答時間の最後にまとめて転記する時間はありません。  
また、解答時間中に音量はいつでも調節できます。

第1問 第1問は問1から問6までの6問です。それぞれの問いについて対話を聞き、答えとして最も適切なものを、四つの選択肢（①～④）のうちから一つずつ選びなさい。

Question No. 1

Question No. 2

M: I'd like eggs with toast and, uh, sausage...no, sorry, I'd rather have bacon.

W: OK. And coffee?

M: Sure.

M: It's over there—the one with a computer on the left and some books on the right.

Question No. 4

M: May I help you?

W: Yes, I'm looking for a sweater.

M: How about one of these? They're usually \$80.00, but you can get 50% off today.

W: That's a good deal!

Question No. 5

M: Ready for the camping trip this weekend?

W: Yeah, almost. Oh, did you check the weather?

M: Yeah, Saturday looks bad—cloudy and rainy. It should clear up on Sunday, though.

Question No. 6

W: How's the study abroad program going?

M: Good. Lots of students went overseas this year.

W: Where to?

M: A few to the UK, some to New Zealand, and the majority to Australia.
